Turning to Scripture...

Jeremiah 18:1-6

- 1. Place small terracotta pots into a paper bag and with a hammer, break the pots
 - 2. Instruct the children not to hit the pots too hard.
- 3. Have them glue the pots back together. (You may plant something in them if desired)
