

Guide to Outdoor Service Members/Attendees

1. Members must bring their own chairs, sunglasses, sun protection such as umbrella, hat, etc.
2. Attendees must wear masks at all times.
3. Members may park in Trinity's lot between the UUG church and the yellow house. Parking is also available in the Borough lot, as well as along High St. Some spaces may be available on the west side of the Housing Authority.
4. Attendees will line up (respecting social distances) on the side walk on High Street and extend the line toward Trinity. They will receive directions and a bulletin from the first usher.
5. Attendees will be assigned a specific space to sit. Their name/s will be recorded on the parking lot schematic. After names are recorded, another usher will escort them to their space. There will be two ushers available to guide members to their spot so that this process is smooth. These ushers will also point out the water and hand sanitizing station as well as the crock that is designated for offerings. A crock will be used so that offering doesn't blow away.
6. Participants will remain seated during the worship service.
7. If a member needs to use the restroom, the policy is only one person is allowed inside at a time. There is a sign on the entrance doors indicating whether or not the restroom is currently available.
8. At the conclusion of the service, members closest to the east exit will be dismissed first. Others will be dismissed following the pattern – those closest to the exit first.
9. Remember that masks must be worn at all times.
10. In cases of inclement weather, the in-person worship is cancelled. As before, the service will be available on line.
