Session 7: Gifts Abound


Turning to Scripture... *Luke 10:1–11* ³⁸Now as they went on their way, he entered a certain village, where a woman named Martha welcomed him into her home. ³⁹She had a sister named Mary, who sat at the Lord's feet and listened to what he was saying. ⁴⁰But Martha was distracted by her many tasks; so she came to him and asked, "Lord, do you not care that my sister has left me to do all the work by myself? Mary has chosen the better part, which will not be taken away from her."

STORY TELLING:

- Review the story of Chris' time in Rick's basement and compare the two stories.

Discussion Questions:

- 2. Ask about their activities that keep them busy. What do they like to do?
- 3. Ask if they can see God in their activities? Talk about their God given talents (gifts) that allow them to have the skills to do their daily activities!
