Luke 12:13-15



STORY TELLING:

- Review the story of Chris and Rick's Lemonade Stand and compare the two stories.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. How does this story of Shaddai and Paladin compare with Chris' story?
- 2. How was Shaddai a giver of things? What was his true gift to the children?
- 3. What might you be able and willing to give to someone else? How much is that worth?



CRAFT/ACTIVITY:

Money Maker

Give each child the money templates and allow them to think about what their money would look like and what would it be worth not only to them, but to someone else. Have them create currency that shows their service toward others, and not greed.
