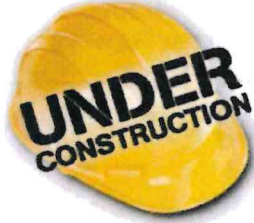
****Don't forget to stop by the easel and sign-up. Still need September 1st 8:00am; September 22nd for both services; and September 29th 8:00am.**
