Mission Central

Since 2002, Mission Central has existed to *connect God's resources with human need* – locally, nationally, and around the world.

Through partnerships with more than 200 organizations, we supply essential resources to those providing humanitarian aid and critical care.

From flood recovery efforts to school supply distributions, or medical equipment, we stand ready to respond – wherever and whenever we're needed.

Mission Central is a 501©(3) nonprofit organization, registered with the IRS and the Pennsylvania Bureau of Corporations and Charitable Org.

C.A.R.E.S. (Combined Area Resources for Emergency Shelter) in Gettysburg has been providing breakfast for their guests in the Youth House at St. James Lutheran Church for the past several years from November through March. The largest group to feed is 30 people. Area churches have been asked to prepare or provide breakfast for the guests at this location. Breakfast is served at 7 am so cooks and helpers arrived at 6 am. Some will prepare eggs, potatoes, pancakes, breakfast sandwiches and breakfast meats. We would also supply cereal, milk, juices, coffee and fruit. Normally 2 adults cooked the breakfast, set up for the breakfast and served it buffet style. Normally an area for dirty dishes is designated which the guests will use. Guests must leave by 8 am. After that time, cleanup should be done. Normally this can be done by 9 am.

This year Pastor Geib of St. James Lutheran Church has asked area churches to help with the task of breakfast preparation. Social Concerns is asking you as a parishioner, if you would be willing to participate with this endeavor in our church (Trinity). We cannot do it without help. Pastor Young has assured us that there are some funds available for purchase of necessary groceries and supplies. However, donations are very acceptable. Listed below are areas where we need help. You may complete the questionnaire or sign up in the gathering area on a list we have provided. Feel free to sign up in more than one area. Completed questionnaires can be left in the offering plate or office.
