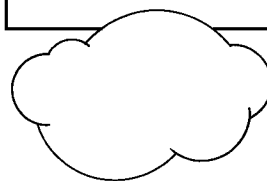

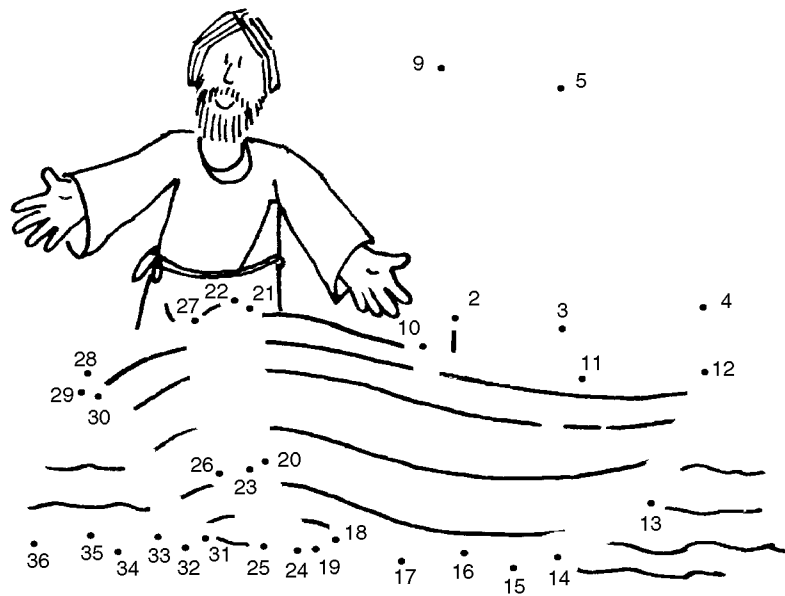
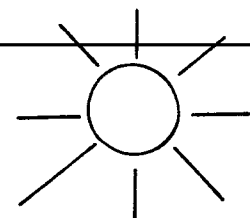
The Parable of the Sower
